The 3 C's – Celebrate, Connect & Contribute

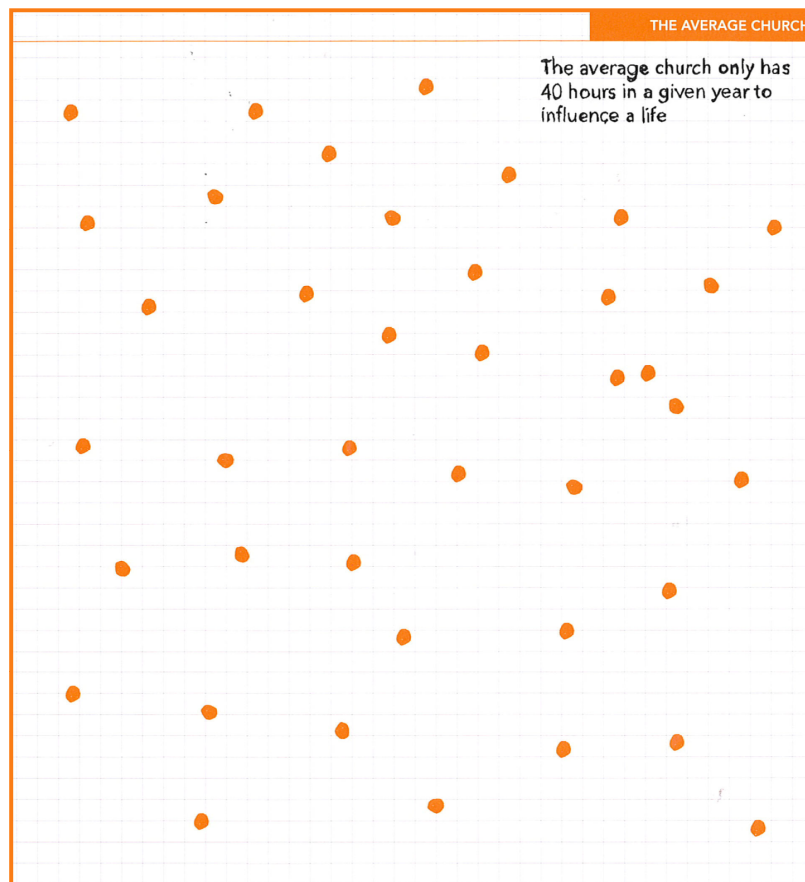
- Almost 500,000 people who don't go to church live within 10 miles of CCC
- As many as 80% of kids raised in the church walk away after they turn 18
- Nearly all the parents of children under the age of 13 (96%) contend that *they* have the primary responsibility for teaching their children values.
- We're trying to create irresistible environments that allow us to capture the hearts and minds of kids so we can **partner with parents** in raising their children in faith and character.

Orange

When it comes to families, we acknowledge that parents are the primary spiritual leaders of their children and we want to do everything possible to help them thrive in that role. We say three things to parents:

1. No one has more potential to influence your child than you.
2. You are not the only influence your children need.
3. Two combine influences will make a greater impact than just two influences.

CCC might have 40 hours each year with the average child or student while parents will have about **3000 hours**. Knowing that parents will have *much* more time with their kids we want to leverage the time we do have to make the parent's time as effective as possible.





There is a reason the color **ORANGE** is used in this illustration:

RED = Family (symbolizes the love families have)

YELLOW = Church (symbolizes the light the church should be – Matthew 5:14 & Revelation 1:20)

ORANGE = Family & Church working together

Environments



Baby Bay (infants)

Baby Bay is where infants hang out during the service with leaders who love providing the best care for your children. Our goal in Baby Bay is **to establish trusted care with families.**

Therefore we want it to be a happy place, where both parent and child have a pleasant experience. We take safety and security seriously; therefore we do everything possible to make it a safe place

for your family. We do all we can to be sure that each little person in our care experiences the love of Jesus.



Kids Kove (Toddlers-Pre-K5)

Kids Kove is our environment for preschool children, age 1 (walking) – Pre-K5. In Kids Kove we want **to create a lasting first impression of their heavenly father.** In doing that, we want children to walk away from Kids Kove knowing three things:

- God made me
- God loves me
- Jesus wants to be my friend forever

We accomplish this by creating an exciting place where children have a consistent leader and experience a loving God. We take safety and security seriously, and do everything possible to make it a safe place for families. A typical Sunday includes a bible story, worship through singing, activities to engage the senses, and small group time.



Discovery Island (Kindergarten – 5th grade)

Discovery Island is our environment for school age children, K-5. In Discovery Island we want **to guide kids to put their faith in Jesus and teach them who God is and how He wants them to live!** This is where children experience small group much like adults do in Group Life. They gather together as a large group to listen to the Bible story and worship through song, and

finish out each morning in small groups engaging in meaningful activities and discussion to reinforce the bottom line.

We concentrate on 3 basic truths:

- I need to make the wise choice
- I can trust God no matter what
- I should treat others the way I want to be treated



KidStuf (K – 5th grade AND their Parents)

KidStuf is a shared experience that encourages kids in grades K-5 and their parents to learn a monthly virtue together. Our goal in KidStuf is **to help families have meaningful conversation about the virtue.** It combines storytelling, drama, lights, music and video to engage and inspire. KidStuf happens on the 1st Sunday of each month but does not take place in Jul-Sep.

CCC Kids Leadership Structure

CCC Leadership Pipeline

Volunteer/Kid >> Apprentice >> Leader >> Coach >> Director

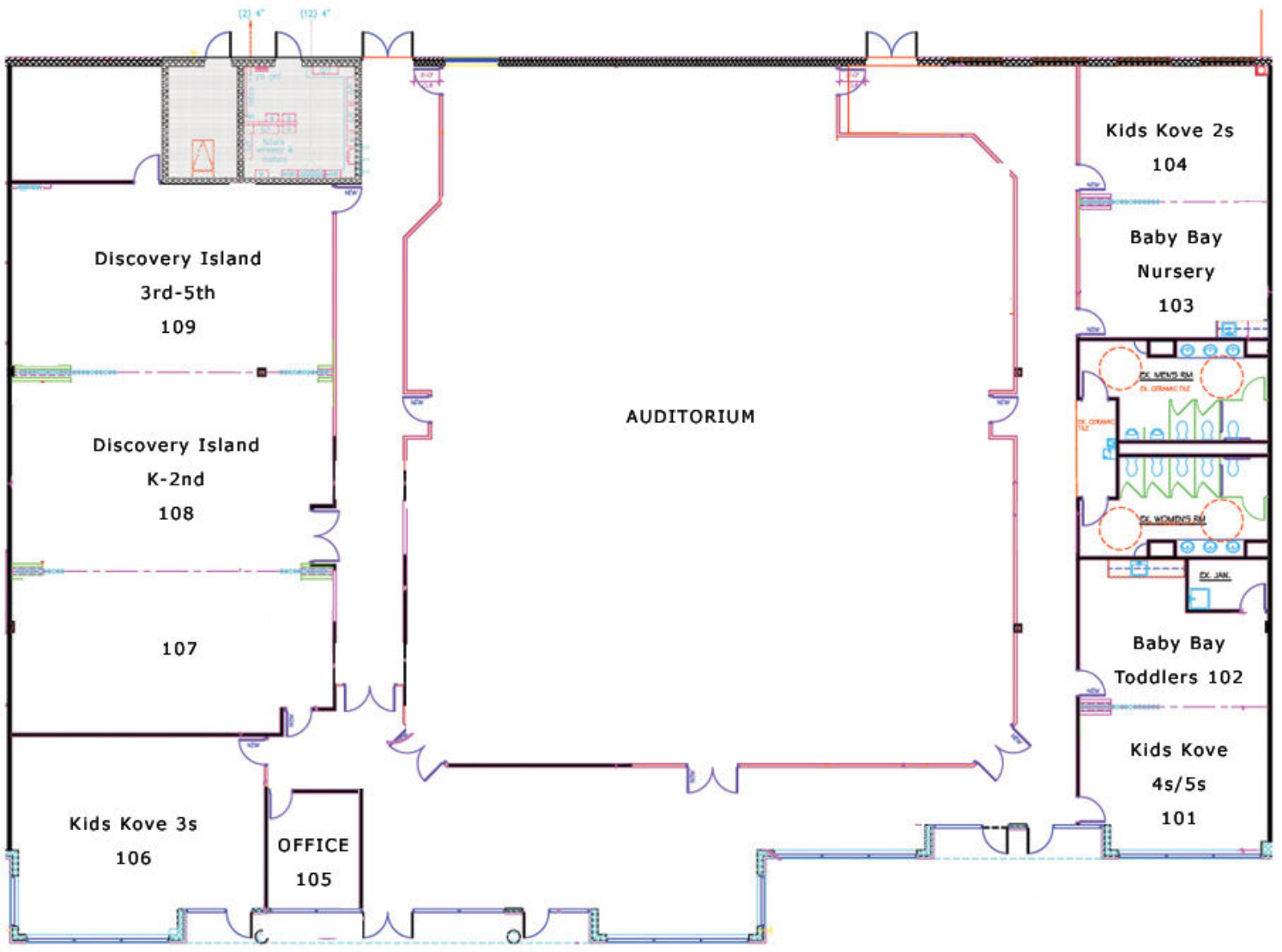
- The Leadership Pipeline is simply about structure and making sure everyone is served, led, and cared for by someone who does not have to care for more than 20 people.
- It is NOT about value. All volunteer roles are valuable.
- The Leadership Pipeline is used universally across all of CCC. But, how that looks organizationally is different for each ministry. CCC Kids Org Charts change as our structure changes with growth.

Elevate

Elevate is our regular gathering for CCC Kids volunteers. It is a chance for everyone in CCC Kids to gather and celebrate, evaluate and improve on what we do while having fun and getting to know each other better. Elevate gatherings can look quite different and happen about 3-4 times/year. All volunteers are expected to attend every Elevate if possible.
