



PLATFORMS

Choosing the platform your website will be built on is the most important choice, as it will determine which host you should use.

WORDPRESS

WordPress powers over 1/3 of all websites, and for good reason. It's a powerful, versatile platform that's fairly easy to manage once it's set up.


WordPress is my favorite because it's free, it's flexible, it's very well-supported, and it's pretty easy to use.




PRO TIP: USE THE DIVI THEME

HOSTING

Once you have chosen your platform, you can decide which hosting option is best. For instance, if you use Squarespace or WIX, they host the site, so the decision is already made. Here are some hosting options.

BLUEHOST

BlueHost is one of the most popular hosting platforms and it's one of the most affordable.

Flywheel is managed WordPress hosting designed to free you from some of the messy details.

WPEngine is one of the most popular managed WordPress hosting options out there and is a great solution.



CHAT BOTS / INTERACTIVES

Chat bots, or conversational apps, can be used on websites to encourage interaction with visitors. My favorite use of them is to help people take small steps in their faith journey online (which is the reason for my favorite choice below).

DRIFT

Drift is a solid option, primarily built for businesses to make a profit, but it can work for churches, too.

INTERCOM

This is probably the most popular chat bot app and certainly the one I see most churches uses. A fine option.

ChatBot is similar to Drift, built for business but it includes a lot of options for customization.

RightMessage is less of a Chat Bot and more of a segmentation tool designed to help people take a step.






MY CHOICE: RIGHTMESSAGE

A ChatBot is a fine app, but my favorite benefit is the ability to segment people so you can invite them to take their best next steps and RightMessage is the app for that.







SEO OPTIMIZATION

SEO stands for Search Engine Optimization, and the goal is to get your website to show up at the top of search results on Google. For Churches, the goal is to do well with **Local SEO** - so people in your area that are searching for things, see your church in results.

YOAST SEO

Yoast is a great SEO Plugin for WordPress. It can help you optimize your content, but it is geared towards general SEO - not local. MISSIONAL MARKETING

Missional Marketing exists to help churches reach people online and Local SEO is something they do very well.

MY CHOICE: MISSIONAL MARKETING


Yoast SEO is a great plugin and I do recommend it, but the team at Missional Marketing are excellent and I am a big believer in outsourcing much of our digital efforts to people who are experts, like Missional Marketing.

GRAPHIC EDITING

Most churches already have a graphic editing solution they use on their team, or they outsource this to a service and they don't need the tools/apps themselves. However, as you expand your digital strategy it's helpful to empower more staff to create digital content. These apps can help.

PHOTOSHOP

This is the gold standard of graphic design programs and I've used it for over 20 years.


Photoshop is the best editor, no doubt, but Canva is the best for widespread use in creating digital content.









MY CHOICE: PRO MEDIA FIRE





When it's free and you need stock photography, find the best image by using all of these options. With that said, Unsplash is where I typically find the most photos.





FILE & PHOTO STORAGE

A good solution for file and photo storage is a must in order to keep things organized and delegate work to multiple staff and/or volunteers.

GOOGLE DRIVE

G Suite is my favorite business suite for churches and Google Drive is good file-storage solution with it.





GOOGLE PHOTOS

If we're talking photos specifically, Google Photos is a good option for storage.

Because Google Drive is my favorite business suite, I also prefer it for file storage. These others have advantages over Google Drive, but I prefer keeping everything in one platform when that is an option.





WRITING TOOLS

Content marketing is a big part of any digital strategy, and this is an area where churches have an advantage. We create content all the time. However, many churches don't use appropriate tools in content creation to ensure quality and consistency throughout the church in content creation.

GRAMMARLY

Grammarly provides basic spell-checking and proofing, but where it really shines is in helping you become a better writer.





EMAIL MARKETING

The term "email marketing" isn't one we would use in churches, but email is a critical piece in creating a digital strategy and there is a lot we can do beyond simply using email to communicate with attenders.

YOUR CHMS

Depending on your Church Management Solution, the email solution built into it may be your best option.

ConvertKit is an email marketing platform designed specifically for marketers.

It's complicated because ConvertKit is by far the best solution among the group, your ChMS would keep everything in one platform (which I prefer), but MailChimp provides many of the advanced features of ConvertKit with the added benefit of integrating with most Church Management Systems.





COMMUNICATION

MASS TEXTING

Without a doubt, text is the best mode of communication if the goal is open rate (98%) or a call to action (CTA). In my opinion, it's great for guest follow up because it leverages both of those benefits without being as direct as a phone call.

TEXT IN CHURCH

Text in Church provides mass texting options along with robust follow up sequences.











MY CHOICE: RESTREAM




MY CHOICE: ZOOM

Zoom is my favorite choice here because of the features and the reliability, but also because of the familiarity. The vast majority of people (in the U.S. at least) are familiar with Zoom making it easy for them to use it with your church.

GROUPS/MEETINGS

MESSAGING

In addition to email and text, there are other messaging options that are helpful as part of a digital strategy for your church. Here are some to consider, a few of which could be used by staff to communicate with volunteers or by small group leaders.

HUDDLE UP

Allows you to send mass messages via email or text with accountability. Use the code **BOOST10** to save 10%.



GROUPS/MEETINGS

SCHEDULING

A digital church strategy should have a way for visitors and attenders to easily schedule meeting time with staff in order to help them take their best next step. These apps can help with that.

CALENDLY

Calendly allows others to schedule time on your calendar based on availability and settings you determine.

SOCIAL MEDIA

SCHEDULING TOOLS

Social media is one of the best tools in the toolkit of a digital church strategy. However, it can also be a burden to manage and a challenge to do it well. These apps can help with scheduling social media posts to save time.

BUFFER

Schedule social media posts across multiple platforms and use the tool to analyze the effectiveness.




SOCIAL CONTENT CREATION

Creating engaging social media content is something every smart organization wants to do, but it's not easy. These tools can help with content creation and don't miss the pro tip below.

SERMON SNAPS

Turn short snippets of your message into shareable content for social media.

CHURCH BUTLER

Choose and schedule posts from Church Butler or have them do it for you.





HEADLINER

Headliner helps you create video posts for social from your audio (like messages).

These solutions are all different, though some of it overlaps. I would absolutely get Sunday Social and Sermon Snaps, then consider the other two depending on budget.



PRO TIP: FOLLOW THE 60/20/20 RULE

Follow the 60/20/20 rule Nils Smith <u>talks about here</u> to make sure you're not using social media as a megaphone.





SOCIAL MEDIA

MESSENGER BOTS

1.3 Billion people use Facebook Messenger and one step churches can take in their digital strategy is to use chatbots in Messenger to connect with page visitors.

MANYCHAT

ManyChat can combine Facebook Messenger and SMS Text to engage visitors.

CHATFUEL

ChatFuel is a bot that requires no code and will integrate with Instagram.

MOBILE MONKEY

Mobile Monkey combines messenger and web chat with a visual builder interface.

MY CHOICE: CHATFUEL

I like ChatFuel the most, but if you do want to integrate SMS Text with Messenger Chat, you'll want ManyChat.





PRO TIP: HELP PEOPLE TAKE EARLY STEPS

Use a chat bot with messenger to interact with people who are early on in their connection with your church. Use it to help them take those early steps in their journey.
