

PART THREE: FAMILY framework

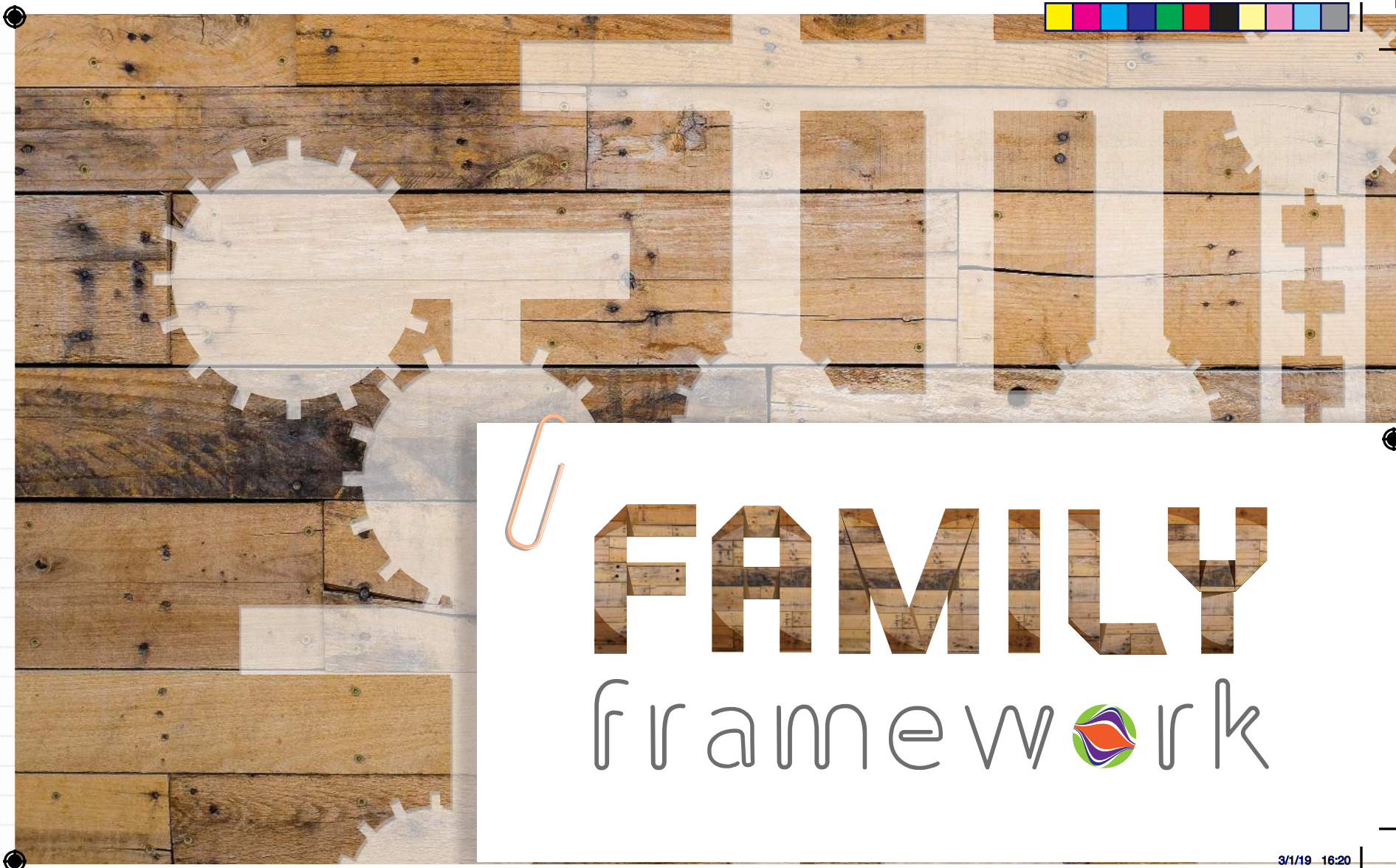
the combination of home and church

The Family Framework is a strategic path of age-appropriate milestones allowing each Northview family to see the next step in their parenting journey.

1. **BABY DEDICATIONS** (0-3 years) – Commit to raising your child in a God-honoring manner.
2. **THE PARENTING GAMEPLAN** (0-18 years) – Develop a plan to biblically parent your child.
3. **FAITH COMMITMENT & BAPTISM PARENT CLASS** (pre-K-4th grade) – This class prepares you to have both a salvation and a baptism conversation with your child when they are ready.
4. **FAMILY EXPERIENCE (FX)** (K-4th grade) Engage in what your child is learning in Northview Kids through this worship and teaching event for the whole family.

5. **BIBLE PRESENTATION** (2nd grade) – Present your child with a Bible to help them begin the spiritual discipline of reading God's Word.
6. **THE BLESSING** (5th/6th grade) – Pass on an intentional blessing to your student through events purposefully designed to engage 5th/6th graders in a meaningful moment.
7. **PURSuing SEXUAL INTEGRITY** (7th-12th grade) – Helping your student establish personal boundaries on their journey toward healthy relationships.
8. **AFFIRMING IDENTITY** (7th-12th grade) – Have meaningful spiritual conversations about your student's identity as a child of God.
9. **MOVING ON TO WHAT'S NEXT** (12th grade) – Create an intentional plan to move your student on to the next phase of their life by developing a mentoring relationship and coming alongside your student in living out their faith.

You have 936 weeks with your child from birth until graduation.

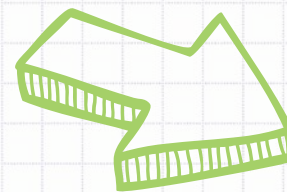
468 WEEKS

PART ONE: THE HOME
